


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Executive Summary

The second phase of the GIZ Project Good Governance Program, result area, Prevention of Violence against Women on developing models and providing process advice for enhancing the quality of services for female victims of violence resulted in the mapping exercise. During this phase, the numbers of districts were extended to further 18 more districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa which was seven in number during the preceding phase of the project. The project duration was 40 days while the districtsfor mapping of gender based violence services were Chitral, Malakand, Buner, Upper Dir, Lower Dir, Shangla, Tank, Kohat, Hangu, Karak, Bannu, LakkiMarwat, Manshehra, Battagram, Kohistan, Torghar, Charsadda and Nowshehra. Out of 18 target districts, mapping is carried out in 14 districts because of lack of reference letter from the Social Welfare, Special Education & Women Empowerment department.

The mapping exercise was conducted in three different phases i.e. inception phase, research phase and project reporting phase. The project was conducted with the help of four teams having male and female in each team with the supervision of project Manager.
